

Preparation Instructions for Interior Treatment of Ants and Spiders

Please be advised that all people and pets (dogs, cats, birds, reptiles, etc.) will need to remain out of the residence for four (4) hours after the treatment. Fish may remain as long as the fish tank is covered and the pump is turned off during treatment – this is the resident's responsibility.

- 1. Remove ALL items (including food) from inside and underneath the cabinets and drawers in the kitchen and bathrooms. Cabinets and drawers must be completely bare.
 - If cabinets and drawers are not completely bare, they will not be treated.
 - All items removed from drawers and cabinets may be placed on the kitchen table and covered with a sheet or cloth.
- **2.** Counter tops must be bare, with the exception of appliances.
- **3.** All clothing, storage items, and furnishings must be moved to a minimum of one (1) foot away from the walls.
- **4. All interior doors are to be left unlocked.** If doors are locked at the time of treatment, the entire home will not be serviced. A charge will occur as though the residence was treated.

UPON COMPLETION OF THE TREATMENT, <u>OCCUPANTS MUST REMAIN OUT OF THE RESIDENCE FOR THE ENTIRE TIME SPECIFIED ON THE NOTICE HUNG ON THE DOOR.</u>
